The question has been asked of me, Pastor McClain what can, or should we do in such chaotic times that we live in today? A time when hatred, violence and unpatriotic actions by white supremacy traitors and others who are opposed to American democracy and freedom for all, especially for Afro-Americans (Black), Latin (Hispanic), Asian, and Korean Americans, and other people of color. Let me be clear, there is no freedom of speech, assembly, right to vote, to protest peacefully, constitution, bill of rights, nor government of, for and by the citizens in nations such as Russia, China, Syria, North Korea, and others whose leaders are dictators that are our sworn enemies, who want to divide and destroy us.

These funds that should have been spent for tutoring and other programs designed to help Black students and other minorities, but due to lack of appropriate use has caused Afro-American students to score last in Math, English, Science, Reading, Writing and History according to the TEA score card for all races of students enrolled at LISD.

Your help and support for democracy, freedom, justice, and equality for all must begin at the school, city and county elections which form the basis for state and federal election issues that we faced today. Remember those who have paved the road for us with arduous work and the thousands who risk or gave their lives. Do not let rules and regulations stop you from casting your vote!
